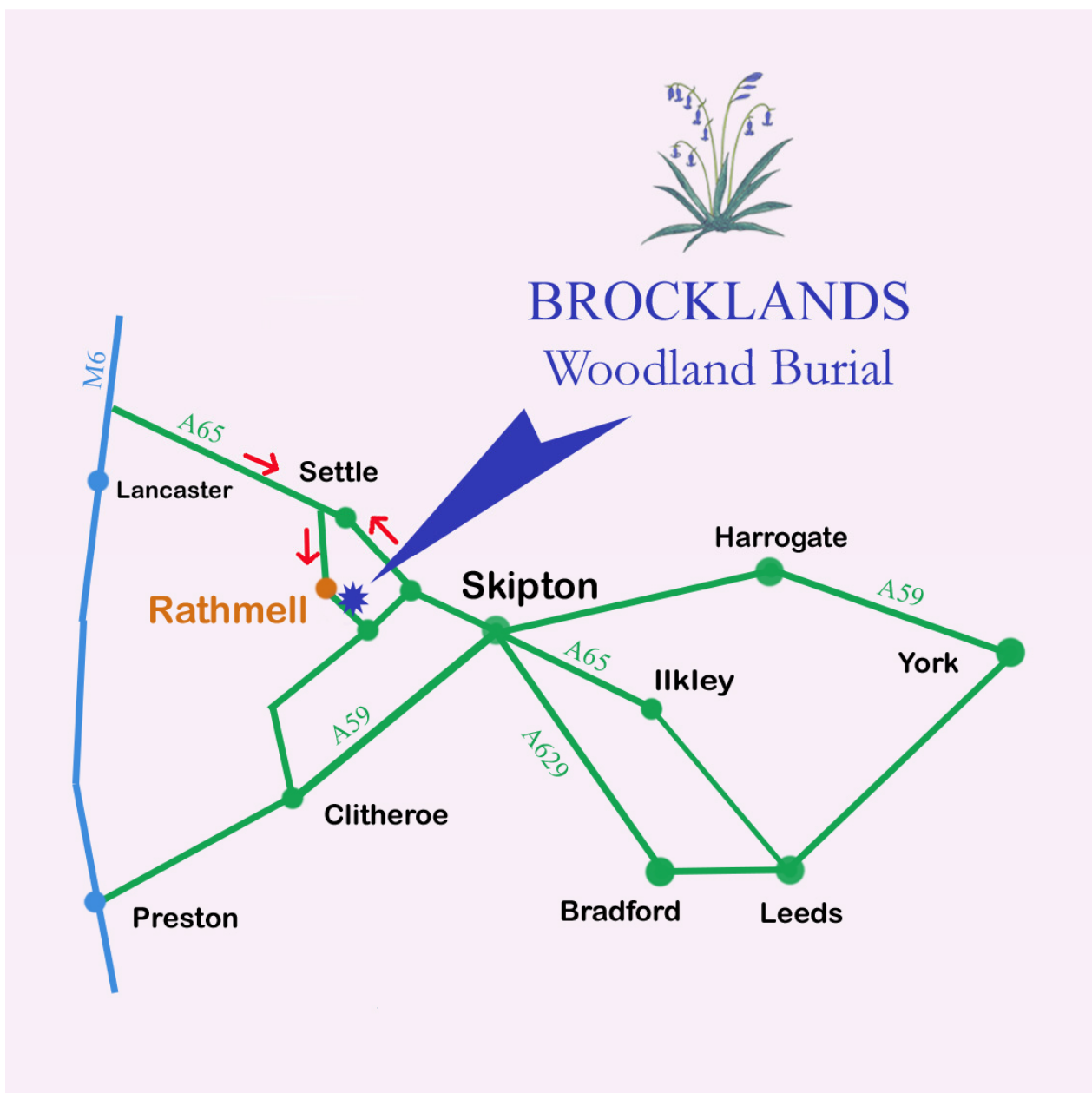


DIRECTIONS TO BROCKLANDS

Brocklands lies on the edge of the village of Rathmell, 3 miles south of Settle in North Yorkshire. Its postcode is shared with at least 7 other properties spread over quite a wide area, so the use of a satnav is not recommended for navigating to the burial site. The safest way to find us is to follow the instructions set out below. If you are lost or not sure which way to go, please ring this number: **07973 983460**

Coming from south the easiest approach is to take the A65 to Settle. At the roundabout before Settle stay on A65 (first exit). Take first left signed Wigglesworth and Rathmell; this takes you under the railway bridge (height limit 11'9") 2 miles to Rathmell; go straight through village and out again. At bottom of slope go over stone bridge and take immediate left to Brocklands.

Travelling from the north take the same exit off the A65 and follow the same route.



If you are approaching from Wigglesworth on the unclassified road from the south, take the left fork towards Settle by The Plough in Wigglesworth (Brocklands is 1.7 miles from this point). Stay on the same road, go past two big stone barns on the right hand side of the road. After the 2nd Stone Barn you will go down a short steep hill, go past the entrance to 'Cappleside' on your left and then almost immediately you will see the entrance to the burial site on your right.
